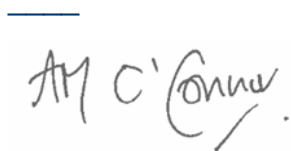
1. I am writing to you in relation to the recent adoption of Variation No. 4 (Variation) to the Kildare County Development Plan 2023-2029 (Development Plan) by the elected members of Kildare County Council (Planning Authority) on 27th April 2026.
2. Having completed its assessment, I am writing to you in the context of the statutory duty of the Office of the Planning Regulator (Office) pursuant to section 63(11) of the Planning and Development Act 2024 (Act) to issue a Notice to you on the basis that, having considered the Variation, the Office is of the opinion that none of the criteria in section 63(10) have been met and, accordingly, the Office is recommending that a draft direction under section 64 should not be issued.
3. No recommendations in respect of the Variation were made by the Minister or the Office during the making of the plan.
4. The Office has undertaken an assessment of the adopted Variation in line with the requirements of section 63, giving particular consideration to:
 - the National Planning Framework First Revision (2025);

- the Regional Spatial and Economic Strategy for the Eastern and Midland Regional Assembly;
- National Planning Policies and Measures;
- National Planning Policy Guidance;
- the Greater Dublin Area Transport Strategy 2022-2042;
- the submission made by the Office at draft stage;
- recommendations and submissions made by prescribed bodies;
- the requirements of Chapter 5 of the Act; and
- those matters in section 547(3) not referred to above
