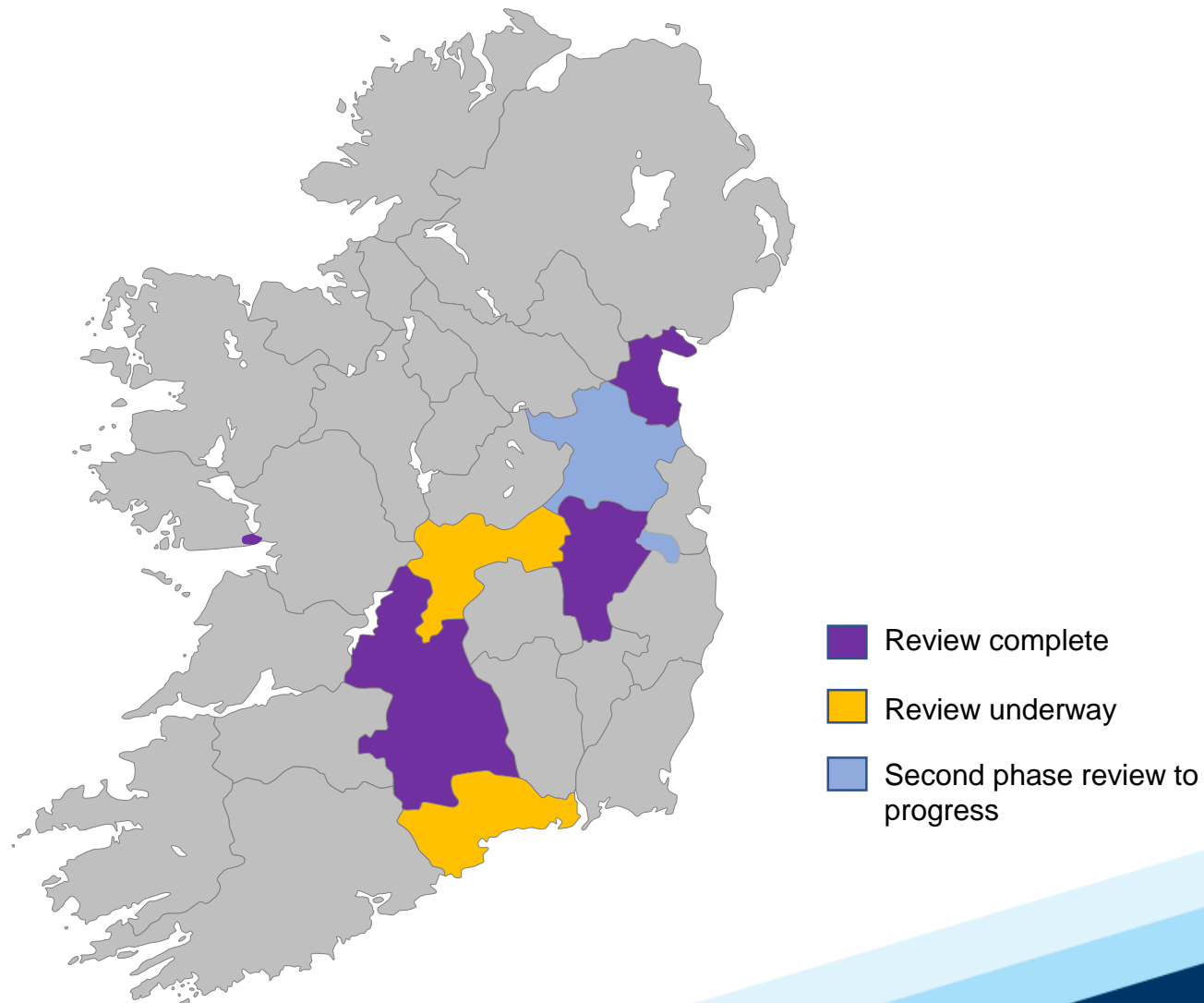


Shared learnings
